We will schedule a student to be on the Morning Show every Wednesday morning. The student will arrive at the station by 6:15 a.m. to spend an hour with Justin learning the basics of a weather forecast.

At 6:32, 6:42, and 6:52 a.m. the student will then, with help and coaching from Justin, present a weather cast. Once the weather cast is complete the student will join Justin, Tim, and Kelly on the news desk for some small chit chat or "cross-talk". Not only will the student be on TV but, with the help of the student's teacher, a classroom visit can be scheduled by Justin or another member of the CBS2 FirstWarning weather team to talk about weather forecasting and severe weather safety. It's a great way to expose young people to the science of weather.
